- 5. Uphold a "water commons" framework in which water is a shared responsibility of all
- 6. Encourage the responsible use of tap water through capital improvements and programming
- 7. Urge community members and other post-secondary institutions to advocate for sustainable water policies worldwide, giving particular attention to the rights of marginalized groups, communities, and individuals
