- Water for 25 thousand people, 35 restaurants, 75 bathrooms; 230 toilets, around 100 drinking fountains
- daily maintenance by a company specialized in artesian wells (chlorine, pipe leaks, sensor in the Water Tank that identifies possible abrupt variations in consumption, maintenance needs, etc.
- - Water tanks cleaned every 6 months
