



Minutes of the 1st international exchange among Blue Universities, October 23, 2023

Agenda:

1. Welcome and introduction by Maude Barlow

Maude welcomes all participants and provides the framework for this exchange, looking back into the history of the Blue Community and the involvement of universities. She sees the network of Blue Communities permanently getting larger and deeper, expressing her hopes for the cooperation among universities.

2. Blue Clusters: The network of Blue Universities

Roland Brunner briefly explains the structure of the Blue Community in Switzerland. From the first three affiliates ten years ago, the network has grown to 45 affiliates, including several high schools and universities. To stimulate and strengthen the exchange among this growing number of Blue Communities, the affiliates are structured into Chapters (regional) and Clusters (by type of organization). Beginning of September, a first exchange happened among the Swiss Blue Universities, organized by the HSG, the University of St. Gallen. To reach out to Blue Universities beyond Switzerland, the first international exchange was organized, happening now on October 23, 2023. 4. International networking/collaboration: Our future exchange

Roland tries to pick up main points from the presentations and the issues raised:

- 1. There are two levels of involvement and of possible exchange among Blue Universities:
 - a. The institutional level: How does the university apply and implement the core principles of the Blue Community (tap water etc.). Lessons learned, best practices, failures. To feed this topic, a <u>web folder</u> is made available, and all are kindly asked to feed it and/or to send relevant information to Roland.
 - b. The level of projects, research, teaching: as water is such a basic topic and at the same time such an essential issue, many faculties and departments may in one way, or another do work on water issues. From history to economics, from natural sciences to philosophy... water may be present everywhere. But often on the institutional level, the university does not know about all this water in their mill. A survey within each university may bring a better understanding and insight.



Roland will provide some basic questionnaire for such a survey. The results could then be shared in form of a database to connect universities also on this level.

2. A next exchange among Blue Universities – with hopefully new affiliates and additional representatives – shall happen next spring, some time in April. Roland will reach out to you to find a date and time.

The present representatives of Blue Universities approve these next steps.

Francois Miller suggests for one of the next meetings to talk about) challenges, difficulties, struggles, lessons learned.

Maude Barlow is closing the first exchange among Blue Universities with encouragement to all of us. Hope is Action and Action is Hope.
